Communications

We also received several e-mails from the State Division of Pensions, which will be on file. We also received several e-mails from the State GovConnect, which will be on file. We received a Notice of Nonrenewal of Insurance from Ace American for the coverage on our above ground fuel tanks. Frank said that he would call VFIS and get the renewal going. We received a notice, from Liberty Mutual Insurance Company, stating that they received our payment for our Workers Compensation Policy. We also received our renewed Workers Compensation Policy. We received a statement, from the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Services, for all abstract retrievals completed for the month of February 2016.

We received a check, from the Township of Howell, which is our first payment for the 2016 Fire Taxes. The check, in the amount of \$233,750.00, was received and deposited on April 2, 2016. We received two invoices, from VFIS, for the changes made to our Accident and Sickness Policy and also our Portfolio Policy. These changes added up to \$2,555.77 and are being paid in tonight's vouchers.

Legal

Joe gave a report, from the New Jersey Government Records Counsel, on an OPRA request involving the Millstone Valley Fire Company. The report stated that both Volunteer Fire Companies and Fire Districts have to supply records for all OPRA requests.

Joe said that the Appraiser is working on the three acre lot at the Route 33 Fire Station Property. As of today, they are not sure if it is non-conforming lot or not. They should have the appraisal completed soon.

Chief's Report

Chief Mike Banasz gave his monthly incident report for March, 2016. The Chief asked the Board to fill out a Training Facility Application Form for the Division of Fire Safety. The Training Classroom at the Route 33 Fire Station now qualifies as State approved facility. The Board said that they agreed with this request and Chairman Carter said he would complete the application. The Chief also said that all five Township Fire Companies have agreed on a common specification for Turn Out Gear and a contract would be in place soon. The only part of the spec that District #2 would not agree on is the color. The Board said that they would let the other Boards know this at the next Executive Board meeting.

Committees

Frank gave a report on the Executive Board meeting, which was held on March 24, 2016. Frank also gave a report on the trucks as follows.

- 1) Absolute repaired the jacks on 19-2-90.
- 2) The new computer has been installed in 19-2-78 and is up and running. We did hire Alconic to help with the set up.
 - 3) Shore Business Solutions came out and repaired the copier in the Chief's office.
 - 4) 19-2-66 vehicle was worked on at Action Chevrolet of Freehold.
- 5) Frank ordered a repair kit for the Fluke Meter at the Route 524 Fire Station. The kit will hopefully repair the screen issue. If not, Frank would like permission to order a replacement meter.
- 6) Frank would like permission to schedule Underwriters Laboratories to complete the annual Ground and Aerial Ladder Tests.

After some discussion, a resolution was offered by Tom Ward and seconded by Doug Howlett, to have Frank schedule the annual ladder tests and to also order a new electrical meter if needed. A roll call vote was taken.
