- 1) 42 pair of extrication gloves, assorted sizes, from Mid-Atlantic Rescue Systems for \$35.99 each for a total of \$1,511.58. This is part of a joint purchase with the other 4 Fire Districts in Howell. Which ended up with a savings of \$10.00 per pair.
 - 2) Ten (10) Unication G1 Pagers from M & W Communications for a total of \$3,614.00.
 - 3) Permission to pre-register for FDIC 2018.
- 4) One (1) computer tower for the Chief's office. They are trying to repair it, but if needed, they would be able to get one for less than \$1,000.00.
 - 5) Six (6) New helmets on State Contract for around \$250.00 each. Total \$1,500.00.
