Communications

We received several e-mails from the State Division of Pensions, which will be on file. We also received several e-mails from the State GovConnect, which will be on file. We received a letter from PEOSHA, concerning the inspection of all PPE at the Route 524 Fire Station. This letter states that all hazards and/or violations identified in the corresponding Order to Comply, were abated during the inspection. This letter also states that PEOSHA considers this case closed and no further action is required. We received an escrow account statement from TD Bank, for Township fees account for the construction of the Route 33 Fire Station. The total left in the account, as of June 26, 2010, is \$2,489.87. We received a fire alarm inspection report, from Complete Security Systems, for the inspection of the system at the Route 524 Fire Station. They replaced four batteries in the boosters and the system passed all tests.

We received a statement, from the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission, for all abstracts obtained in June, 2010. We received service report, from Clean Air, for the annual inspection of the Vehicle Exhaust System at the Route 524 Fire Station. We received a letter from Norris, McLaughlin & Marcus, PA, Attorneys at Law, stating that they have all project files from CMX, formerly Schoor DePalma. CMX has gone out of business and Norris, McLaughlin & Marcus is

making records available to any Companies concerned. The cost for this is \$750.00 to cover administrative fees. No action was taken at this time. We received a request from Glatfelter Claims Management stating that they needed a copy of the Police Report from the incident with 19-2-76. George faxed this report to VFIS on July 30, 2010. We received a Subpoena from Leary, Bride, Tinker and Moran for three members for August 5, 2010 at 10:00AM. Wayne Gravatt, Brian Prochnow and Frank Biddle III have to be at the Howell Town Hall to answer questions about an incident from February 6, 2007.
