Committees

Frank gave a report from the Executive Board Meeting, which was held on July 26, 2012. Frank said that the Fire Bureau will be moving to the New Town Hall on August 9, 2012. They will be in temporary offices until their new offices are completed. They had to move earlier than originally planned because of the discovery of a rabid bat in their old building. Frank also gave a report on the trucks as follows.

- 1) 19-2-90 was sent to Campbell Supply for service and repair. It came back on July 25, 2012, but still has some issues.
- 2) 19-2-90 is scheduled for the UL recertification retest on August 10, 2012.
- 3) 19-2-76 has some rear brake problems and is at Allied Diesel for repairs and service.
- 4) Chief Tice's vehicle received new tires at Edwards Tire the week of July 30, 2012.
- 5) Art installed the New Front LED Warning Lights on 19-2-76.
- 6) Art has also been working on the headlights and air conditioning on 19-2-85.
- 7) Frank will be picking up the remainder of the air system piping from Grainger tomorrow. This is to repair the compressed air system at the Route 33 Fire Station.
- 8) East Coast Emergency Lighting has started the work on 19-2-96 and will finish later this month.
- 9) Chief Prochnow had his vehicle serviced at Jiffy Lube.
- 10) The Bus has a fuel leak and is parked out back at the Route 524 Fire Station until we have time to repair it.

Old Business

George said that both he and Frank went out to confirm the locations of the additional Fire Hydrants that N. J. American Water has been charging us for the last couple months. The additional hydrants are all located in Aquestra development. George said that we started to pay for these additional hydrants in tonight's bills.

George said that there is a problem with the new computer, Windows 7, and the Sharp copier/printer. He said that The Copier Center is coming tomorrow to see if they can make them all work together.

New Business

Frank said that we received a quote, from The Clean Air Company, for the annual service on the Vehicle Exhaust Systems at both Fire Stations. The amount of the quote is \$931.00, plus any parts that are needed. A resolution was offered by Tom Ward and seconded by Doug Howlett, to have this annual work completed by The Clean Air Company.
