We received several e-mails from the State Division of Pensions, which will be on file. We also received several e-mails from the State GovConnect, which will be on file. We received a Fire Alarm and Detection Equipment Test Report from Complete Security Systems. This report is for the Route 524 Fire Station and was completed on July 14, 2014. A copy of this report was sent to the Howell Township Fire Bureau. We received an Air System Inspection Report from Continental Fire and Safety. This report is for the service of our breathing air compressor at the Route 524 Fire Station. We received a letter, from Glatfelter Claims Management, stating that they are handling our claim for the accident involving 19-2-78 on July 11, 2014. Frank has been communicating with Glatfelter since the accident.

We received an Affidavit of Publication, from the Asbury Park Press, for the advertising of Invitation to Bidders. We received a new toner cartridge from Shore Business Solutions. The new cartridge is covered under our service contract.

Legal

Joe said that we were supposed to receive bids tonight for the New Chevrolet Suburban Chief's Vehicle. Joe said that we failed to remember that bids cannot be received on a Monday in New Jersey. Several Bidders stated that they would not bid on the vehicle if the bid opening was held on Monday, August 4, 2014. Joe said that he would advertise the Bid Opening if the Board picked another date. Joe said that Assembly Bill number 3006 has to do with the consolidation of Fire Districts. Joe read the rules as to how a consolidation should be carried out. A lot of discussion followed as the Board feels that a consolidation in Howell Township would not be cost effective.

Chief Bob Tice gave his incident report for the month of July, 2014. The Chief's would like to purchase the following items.
