Communications

We received several e-mails from the State Division of Pensions, which will be on file. We also received several e-mails from the State GovConnect, which will be on file. We received two service reports, from EMR Power Systems, for work completed on our two Emergency Generators. The two service checks, with load, were completed on November 26, 2014. Joe said that all Petitions for the position of Commissioner needed to be in the Clerks hands by January 20, 2015. Joe asked Frank to call him on January 21, 2015 and give him all the names so he could have them put on the ballot.

Chief's Report

Chief Bob Tice gave his incident report for the month of December, 2014 and also the yearend report for 2014. Chief Tice asked to have a long range meeting at 7:00 PM on February 2, 2015 before the next Commissioners meeting.

Second Assistant Chief Mike Whitehill said that received prices to strip the trade in Suburban before we give it to Hertrich Fleet Services. The prices are as follows.

- 1) Remove all Emergency Lighting from current Chief's Vehicle by East Coast Emergency Lighting for a total of \$600.00.
- 2) Remove all exterior decals and strips from current Chief's Vehicle by Ken's Body Works for a total of \$400.00.

A resolution was offered by George Patten and seconded by Tom Ward, to have East Coast and Ken's strip the current Chief's Vehicle before we trade it in. A roll call vote was taken.

Committees

Frank gave a report on the Executive Board meeting which was held on December 18, 2015. Frank gave the Chief's a new set on plans for the Boulder Ridge Development on Route 33 so they could approve the Fire Hydrant locations. Frank will give the plans back to the Fire Bureau at the next E-Board meeting on January 23, 2015.

Frank also gave a report on the trucks as follows.

- 1) 2-90 was repaired and serviced at Absolute and put back in service on December 5, 2014.
- 2) 2-90 started having problems with the jack controls and Absolute said that the jack module would have to be sent out for repairs and it would take around 3 to 4 weeks. Repairs approved.
- 3) New Jersey Emergency Vehicles repaired 2-66's vehicle and all work was completed on warranty.
- 4) The gear for the generator on 2-85 was pushed back to mid-January, 2015.
- 5) The New Chief's Vehicle is in at Hertrich Fleet and should be delivered mid-January, 2015.
- 6) Campbell Supply repaired 2-75 for the lean issue and Frank picked up the truck on December 19, 2014. While working on the truck Campbell found two bent brackets that hold the water tank in the truck. Campbell ordered the new brackets and will repair this issue on warranty.
- 7) The Route 33 Fire Station Air Compressor was repaired by Graga Construction and they will come back and service the unit next week.
- 8) First Priority is working on a water leak at the pump panel on 2-78.
- 9) Frank received prices on the decals needed for the New Chief's Vehicle. The total should be around \$900.00 from Precision Art.

A resolution was offered by Tom Ward and seconded by Doug Howlett, to purchase the needed items from Precision Art. A roll call vote was taken.

Old Business

George said that we still have not received the approved 2015 Budget from the State. Bob Hulsart will be calling them to find out what's going on.

Air Power International has called to voice their opinion about the Breathing Air Compressor award. They are claiming that the unit that we have awarded to Continental Fire & Safety does not meet the specifications. After lots of discussion, the Board feels that the unit that was ordered does in fact meet the specifications.

We had an inspection by PEOSH during the month of December, 2015. We did receive one violation for the Breathing Air Cylinders on 19-2-90 being out of date for hydro testing. Frank took the truck to Jersey Coast Fire Equipment to have the bottles removed for testing the next day. The bottles will be installed back on 19-2-90 as soon as the truck comes back from Absolute. Since we showed the PEOSH inspector the bill from Jersey Coast, the violation was abated.

New Business

George said that he is not happy with the way the State of New Jersey approves our Budget. Every year we seem to turn it in earlier and it comes back even later. The State assured us that they would act on the Budgets as a first in first out basis and we feel that that is not the case.

George Gravatt said that we needed a lot of electrical supplies for the Route 33 Fire Station. He is looking for permission to purchase the needed supplies and make the repairs. A resolution was offered by Tom Ward and seconded by Harry Carter, approving the purchases and repairs as needed. A roll call vote was taken.
