### **REGULAR MEETING**

## **Communications**

We received several e-mails from the State Division of Pensions, which will be on file. We also received several e-mails from the State GovConnect, which will be on file. We received an e-mail from the N. J. State Division of Pensions concerning employer demographic changes required online through EPIC. We need to keep current the names of the people that serve as Certifying Officer and Supervisor of the Certifying Officer. Any changes to these two individuals will need to be updated as soon as possible online with EPIC. We received an Air System Inspection Report, from Continental Fire and Safety, for work performed on our Eagle Talon Breathing Air Compressor on December 14, 2012. We received an Annual Fire Prevention Inspection Report, from the Howell Township Fire Bureau, for inspections completed on December 26, 2012. The following items need to be corrected,

- 1) An occupancy load must be posted in the meeting room at the Route 33 Fire Station.
- 2) The loose propane cylinders in the engine bays at the Route 33 Fire Station must be stored outside in an area protected from the public.
- 3) The one missing ceiling tile in the men's room at the Route 33 Fire Station must be installed.
- 4) The kitchen ventilation equipment in the Morton Building must be cleaned according to schedule. It is currently overdue.
- 5) An internally illuminated exit sign with directional arrow must be installed in the Old Fire House near the stairway to the second floor.

We received some updated information from Valic, our LOSAP provider, stating that a new fund will be added to the choices available in the program. We received a final bill from AmeriGas, after our switching over to natural gas at the Route 33 Fire Station. AmeriGas pumped out the remaining propane and removed the three large storage tanks. The cost included with this work was calculated into the final bill. This action resulted in a credit of \$4,021.75. The check, in the amount of \$4,021.75, was received and deposited on December 21, 2012. We received a letter, from JCP&L, stating that our account has been rebilled from August 31, 2012 to November 12, 2012 due to an over estimate. We received an Annual Reconciliation of Tax Withheld form from the N. J. State Division of Taxation. Paychex takes care of this for us each year. We received the Affidavit of Publication, from the Asbury Park Press, for the publication of the Public Hearing on our proposed 2013 Budget.

We received Holiday Greetings from the following Companies,

- 1) Fail Safe Testing, fire hose testing.
- 2) Firefighter One, fire, police, and ems supplies.
- 3) VFIS, insurance.
- 4) G & L Lawn Service, lawn maintenance.
- 5) Sakoutis Brothers Disposal, refuge collection.

We received a service report, from Absolute Fire Protection, for the work performed on 19-2-78. This report stated that more work is needed and the truck will have to go to their shop to be completed. We received two service reports, from EMR Power System, for the service checks on our two Emergency Generators. This work was completed on December 5, 2012.

## Legal

Joe went over the timeline for the election again and said that the last date to file for the position of Commissioner is January 2, 2013. Joe asked Frank to call him on January 21, 2013 and tell him the names of the Candidates.

# Chief's Report

Chief Bob Tice gave the incident report for the month of December 2012. Chief Tice also gave a short report for the year 2012. We had a total of 439 calls for the year. Chief Tice also said that they would provide the names of the Firefighters selected to attend the FDIC in Indianapolis at the February 2013 meeting.

## **Committees**

Frank gave a report on the Executive Board meeting which was held on December 13, 2012. Frank also gave a report on the trucks as follows,

- 1) 19-2-90 is back in service and performing well at this time.
- 2) 19-2-78 was serviced by Absolute. The truck will need to go up to Absolute for some more work sometime in January.
- 3) The light tower on 19-2-85 was repaired. We will be keeping an eye on it to see how it is working.
- 4) Defender came back and finished the work on 19-2-96.
- 5) Trius repaired the plow on 19-2-98.
- 6) Edwards replaced all six tires on 19-2-93.
- 7) Frank and Jeff repaired the flagpole at the Route 33 Fire Station. We will need to get the bearing assembly replaced on the top of the flagpole. Frank will call for prices.

## **Old Business**

George said that the price for the software and hardware for the Stanley Electronic Door Locks is around \$2,932.15. George thinks that we do not need all the items on the quote and he will contact the vendor and get a new quote.

George said that Breeze Heating and Air Conditioning came and checked out our heat and ac system at the Route 33 Fire Station. George said that the technician removed moisture saturated insulation from the ductwork in the attic and said that he would be back in the spring to repair. This ductwork is only for the air conditioning system and does not need to be repaired at this time. A short discussion was had on the servicing of the HVAC Systems at the Route 33 Fire Station. After this discussion, a resolution was offered by George Patten and seconded by Tom Ward, to enter into an annual maintenance agreement with Breeze Heating and Air Conditioning for the Route 33 Fire Station. A roll call vote was taken.
