#### Communications

We received several e-mails from the State Division of Pensions, which will be on file. We also received several e-mails from the State GovConnect, which will be on file. We received an e-mail from Underwriters Laboratories, which contained our ground ladder report. All ground ladders passed. We received a second e-mail from Underwriters, which contained the preliminary findings from the Aerial Truck Inspection. This report stated that the Aerial failed for 2 things. The waterway has a leak that needs to be repaired and the waterway relief valve needs to be rebuilt.

We received a check from Liberty Mutual, which is an over payment on our Workers Compensation Policy. The check, in the amount of \$139.00, was received and deposited on April 17, 2010. We also received our final audit for our Workers Compensation Policy. This audit resulted in a \$2,838.00 credit. We received another credit invoice from Liberty Mutual for a total of \$5,582.00. We then received a check from Liberty Mutual for this credit invoice.

The check, in the amount of \$5,582.00, was received and deposited on April 12, 2010. We received an invoice from Sound Billing for an oil change on the 2004 Chiefs car. This invoice, in the amount of \$35.98, was paid with credit that we have with Sound Billing. We received a check from VFIS for the claim we turned in for the accident Bob Tice had with his Chiefs car. The check, in the amount of \$1,265.14, was received and deposited on April 7, 2010.
