REGULAR MEETING

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Harry Carter, at 7:00 PM.

A Roll call was taken showing George Patten, Frank Biddle III, Harry Carter, Doug Howlett and Robert Tice present. Also in attendance was Joseph Youssouf, Board Attorney. The Chairman then led all in attendance with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The check, in the amount of \$261.00, was received and deposited on May 26, 2020. We received the minutes from the March 7, 2020 New Jersey State Association of Fire Districts Meeting. We received two service reports, from EMR Power System, for the two service checks completed on our two Emergency Generators on May 8, 2020. We received an email from the Division of Local Government Services, stating that the Township of Howell did not send them a copy of the resolution approving our 2020 Fire District Budget. Frank sent them a copy and also the revised pages of the 2020 Budget. These documents were also sent to NetLink to post on our website.

Chief's Report

Chief Greg Player gave his incident report for the month of May 2020. Chief Player said that he would like permission for the following.

1) To send up to four members to the RIT Certification Course at All Hands Fire Training. The cost would be \$250.00 per student.

2) To reimburse members that sign up and attend the Boardwalk Fire Conference in Asbury Park on October 16 thru the 18, 2020. The cost for this conference is \$190.00 per student.

7) Jersey Coast hydro tested the breathing air cylinders mounted on 19-2-90.

8) 19-2-67's vehicle was repaired at Brannings Freehold Auto Body.

9) 19-2-68's vehicle was serviced at Jiffylube.

10) Defender Emergency Products has been called to repair several issue on 19-2-96. They have ordered some parts and will call when they are ready to work on it.
