REGULAR MEETING

Notice of time, date, location and agenda of the meeting, to the extent then known, was duly published in accordance with the requirements of the "Open Public Meeting Act' at least 48 hours in advance of this meeting by posting and by publication in the official newspapers of the district.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Robert Tice, at 8:00 PM.

A Roll call was taken showing George Patten, Frank Biddle III, Doug Howlett, Robert Tice and Kathleen Carter present. The Chairman then led all in attendance with the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by George Patten and seconded by Kathleen Carter; to approve the minutes of the last meeting held on December 5, 2022, motion carried.

The meeting agenda was changed in order for the adoption of the 2023 Fire District Budget to take place.

Frank read the results of the Special Meeting, which was held on December 20, 2022. This Special Meeting was held to gain voter approval for two (2) Capital Projects in the Proposed 2023 Fire District Budget. The two (2) Project questions were as follows.

- 1) Shall the Commissioners of Fire District No. 2, in the Township of Howell, County of Monmouth, be authorized to expend not to exceed of \$60,000.00 for the purchase and installation of New Station Air Systems at Both Fire Stations?
- 2) Shall the Commissioners of Fire District No. 2, in the Township of Howell, County of Monmouth, be authorized to expend not to exceed of \$140,000.00 for the purchase and installation of a replacement Emergency Generator for the Route 524 Fire Station?

The results for both questions were 23 voters for and 0 voters against. These results were uploaded to the New Jersey FAST System.

George read the Proposed 2023 Fire District Budget as follows.

We received several e-mails from the State Division of Pensions, which will be on file. We also received several e-mails from the State GovConnect, which will be on file. We received a check, from GovDeals, for the sale of the 2009 Chevrolet Suburban. The check, in the amount of \$6,800.00, was received and deposited on December 19, 2022. We received a letter, from Corebridge Financial, explaining some updates to our LOSAP Program. Corebridge Financial has taken over VALIC, which was our LOSAP Program Provider.

We received some communications from the County Election Division about the upcoming Fire District Election. Frank filled out all the paperwork requested and returned to the County. After January 23rd, Frank will let the County know the names of the Candidates running for the office of Fire Commissioner and also the Budget Question.

We received the minutes from the last Joint Board Meeting, which was held on December 1, 2022.

Legal

Frank said that we should establish a Temporary Budget for 2023. Frank said that last year we set the Temporary Budget at \$170,000.00. This would be used from January 1, 2023 thru March 6, 2023. After some discussion, a resolution was offered by George Patten and seconded by Frank Biddle III, establishing a Temporary 2023 Budget in the amount of \$170,000.00. A roll call vote was taken.

Bob gave a report on the Howell Radio System upgrade. The Township Ordinance passed and things are moving forward at a slower pace than we would like. The Township still says that they are waiting for our Budget to pass on February 18, 2023, before moving forward.

Chief's Report

Chief Dan Roth gave his incident report for the month of December, 2022. He also gave the yearend report for all of 2022. The Chief said that we still have some credit at FDIC from the pandemic years. This credit will be used for FDIC 2023. Chief Roth would like the Board to look into updating the meal stipend given to Firefighters attending FDIC. A discussion was also held on Workers Compensation injuries.

Committees

Frank gave a report on the trucks and equipment as follows.

- 1) Continental came out to both Fire Stations to look at the proposed Station Air Systems.
 - 2) Campbell Supply was here and made repairs to 2-75 and 2-78.
 - 3) 2-88 was taken to Freehold Ford for an issue with the engine.
 - 4) 2-66's vehicle was taken to Lester Glenn for a starter issue.
- 5) The CO Sensors in the truck bays of the Route 33 Fire Station are past their lifespan and are in need of replacement. We are looking into the replacement.
 - 6) Absolute will be coming out to repair the two front light bars on 2-90.
- 7) The two new Electronic Locks were ordered. We also asked them to send us four new battery packs for some of our locks. These were delivered.

Old Business

Bob asked the Board to come up with a list of things that need to get completed around both Fire Stations.

New Business

George asked the Board about recovering the unvested LOSAP funds for the Firefighters that Chief Dan Roth said were let go from the Fire Company. George also asked the Board if he should cancel the Life Insurance for all the Firefighters that Chief Dan Roth said were let go from the Fire Company. After some discussion, a motion was offered by Doug Howlett and seconded by Frank Biddle III, to recover the LOSAP funds of the Firefighters that were not vested and to also cancel the Life Insurance of the Firefighters that were let go. Motion passed.

We received a contract proposal, from Continental Fire & Safety, for the care of the Breathing Air Compressor at the Route 524 Fire Station. The quote is for a total of \$1,998.00. After a short discussion, a resolution was offered by Bob Tice and seconded by George Patten, to enter into this contract with Continental Fire & Safety for 2023. A roll call vote was taken.
