### **Communications**

We also received several e-mails from the State Division of Pensions, which will be on file. We received a check, from the Township of Howell, for the early voting use of the Route 33 Fire Station. The check, in the amount of \$900.00, was received and deposited on April 20, 2023. We received another check, from the Township of Howell, which is our first payment from the 2023 Fire Taxes. The check, in the amount of \$271,787.50, was received and deposited on April 7, 2023. We received a notice, from the Township of Howell, stating that our Backflow Preventer at the Route 33 Fire Station is due for inspection.

Several emails were received about this year's Early Voting and Primary Voting coming up from June 2<sup>nd</sup> to June 6<sup>th</sup>. We received a reminder, from the Township of Howell, that all Fire Commissioners need to fill out their Financial Disclosure Statements for 2023. We received a reminder about the June 3<sup>rd</sup> New Jersey State Association of Fire Districts meeting at the Route 33 Fire Station. We received an invitation to the Retirement Celebration for Chief Robert Lewis of the Howell Township Fire Bureau on June 2, 2023.

## Chief's Report

Chief Dan Roth gave his incident report for the month of April 2023. The Chief would like to purchase the following items.

- 1) Five (5) sets of Turnout Gear from SAFE-T for a total of \$21,334.75 on New Jersey State Contract.
- 2) Eight (8) Five (5) Gallon pails of Class B Foam, from Continental Fire & Safety, for a total of \$2,710.00, which includes shipping.

- 3) Two (2) Kochek double female adapters and One (1) Camlock Adapter, from Continental Fire & Safety, for a total of \$944.00.
  - 4) Fast Board Training for a total of \$5,150.00, given by the makers of the Fast Board.
- 5) One (1) Power Eagle hot water pressure washer, with 100-foot hose reel and undercarriage cleaner, from HOT Sales & Service, for a total of \$8,124.00. Price includes shipping.

After some discussion, a resolution was offered by George Patten and seconded by Kathleen Carter, to purchase the Chief's requests. A roll call vote was taken.

Second Assistant Chief Stephen Smith asked the Board some questions about the upgrade of the Howell Fire Radio System. The questions mainly pertained to Fire Ground Channels after we arrived at the scene. Chairman Tice said that he would check on these questions and get back with the Chiefs.

### **Committees**

Frank gave a report on the trucks and equipment as follows.

- 1) Three vehicles were serviced at Jiffy Lube, 2-66, 2-67, and 2-88.
- 2) Both heater hoses were replaced on 2-93.
- 3) The Front Brow Light on 2-78 is back up and working. This light is a lot better than the old one.
  - 4) 2-78 will be going to Defender for service soon.
- 5) We called for service of the Gear Washing Machine at the Route 524 Fire Station. Waiting for a call as to when they will be coming out.

Bob gave a report on the Radio Upgrade Project. Currently, the Township is offering \$500.00 a year for the installation of the New Radio Tower and the use of the building for the equipment.

Bob said that the Warning Light for the entrance of the Route 33 Fire Station is in the Design Phase.

### **Old Business**

George said that the books are at the Auditor. Mr. Hulsart did have a few questions, which George answered, and we should be getting everything back shortly.

George asked Mr. Braslow to investigate the uncashed checks made out to Brice's auto Supply.

George said that he will call Cooper Electric about the Installation of a New Emergency Generator for the Route 524 Fire Station.

Katie said that she did go over the issues we have been having with Access Health. They are scheduled for this year's Firefighter Physicals on June 28, 2023.

Bob asked the Chiefs again about the changes he wants to make to the MARP. A lot of discussion was had about what changes, if any, should be made at this time. Bob's changes would add a third company to one or more of the Boxes in our Fire District. Several Chiefs and Commissioners spoke their minds about this subject.

More Radio Upgrade talk was had after Rich Touroonjian called into the meeting. Rich said that he would get answers to all the questions. Bob said that he would also follow up with Rich.

A discussion was had on the pile of excess equipment out in the Engine Bay of the Route 33 Fire Station. After some time, a resolution was offered by Bob Tice and seconded by Kathleen Carter, declaring this equipment as excess and to list it on the Gov Deals website. A roll call vote was taken.
