### **Communications**

We received several e-mails from the State Division of Pensions, which will be on file. We also received several e-mails from the State GovConnect, which will be on file. We received a check, from the Township of Howell, for the use of the Route 33 Fire Station for the early, primary, and general election voting. The check, in the amount of \$1,600.00, was received and deposited on December 23, 2023. We received an email from the DCA, stating that our 2024 Adopted Budget was submitted and passed on for review.

We received an email on December 12, 2023, from the New Jersey Division of Pensions, that our 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2023 IROC is ready for processing. We received another email, from the New Jersey Division of Pensions, stating that our Employer Liability for Annual Pension Contribution was also ready to be processed. This payment, in the amount of \$3,381.00, was made on December 27, 2023. We received confirmation, from the Division of Pensions, that our 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2023 IROC was submitted.

We received a Notice of Violations, from the Howell Township Fire Bureau, for a few things at the Route 33 Fire Station. They needed the latest reports for our Emergency Generator Service, the latest report of our Fire Alarm Inspection, and the Dryer Vent cleaning report. All these things are in the works.

## Legal

Frank said that we needed to set up a Temporary Budget to get us through from January to March 4, 2024. The Temporary Budget is allowed to be 14% of the 2023 Fire District Budget, minus Capital Appropriations, debt, or interest redemption. That would bring us to \$183,260.00. A resolution was offered by George Patten, and seconded by Kathleen Carter, establishing a Temporary Budget for 2024 in the amount of \$183,260.00. A roll call vote was taken.

After some discussion, a resolution was offered by Frank Biddle III, and seconded by Jeffrey DiGraitis, to Authorize Encumbrance of \$150,000.00 Relative to the 2023 Budget Surplus to pay for the Warning Light. Chief Tim McKay gave his incident report for the month of December 2023. The Chief handed out a Driver Training Program proposal from Central Jersey Compliance Company, for the Board to look over. The cost of this program would be \$2,000.00. The Chief asked to purchase the following items.

- 1) To start the process of securing rooms for the FDIC for six (6) Firefighters.
- 2) CPR Refresher from Joseph Doyle for an estimated \$1,000.00. The price would vary depending on the number of participants.
  - 3) RTK/BBP Refresher from Central Jersey Compliance Company, for \$300.00.

After some discussion, a resolution was offered by Frank Biddle III, and seconded by Kathleen Carter, to allow the Chief to schedule FDIC, and the two (2) Training Refreshers. A roll call vote was taken.

## **Committees**

Bob said that he attended a Radio Upgrade Meeting on December 12, 2023, at the storage warehouse to inspect our equipment. Bob said that all the equipment we ordered is there. He also said that the installation process should be starting in early spring 2024.

Frank gave a report on the Trucks and equipment as follows.

- 1) 2-90 was completed and put back in service on December 15, 2023.
- 2) 2-78 was completed early and brought back by Campbell Supply on December 19, 2023.
  - 3) The driveway snowplow markers were installed at the Route 33 Fire Station.
- 4) The Truck Committee has finished going over the specs for the New Aerial Truck and would like the Board to place the order.
- 5) The Truck Committee will be meeting with New Jersey Emergency Vehicles on January 9, 2024, to see if they are interested in building the Tractor for 2-96.
- 6) It looks like the onboard Battery Charger on 2-75 has stopped working. Campbell Supply will be coming by to check it out. Frank set up a shop battery charger to keep the truck batteries charged.
- 7) EMR Power Systems came out for a service call on the Emergency Generator at the Route 524 Fire Station. There was an issue with the unit starting during a power outage in early December 2023.

### **Old Business**

George said that the Boiler at the Route 33 Fire Station passed inspection in December. Hartford Steam Boiler completed the job.

George said that we received an updated quote, from Foley Power Systems, for the installation of a New 125KW Emergency Generator at the Route 524 Fire Station. The quote is for \$196,928.00 on the Sourcewell Co-op. After some discussion, a resolution was offered by Bob Tice, and seconded by Frank Biddle III, to place the order for the New Emergency Generator from Foley Power Systems. A roll call vote was taken.
