Communications

We received several e-mails from the State Division of Pensions, which will be on file. We also received several e-mails from the State GovConnect, which will be on file. We received a communication from George Marcouiller, formerly from BurMarc, stating that he has started a new company. The new company is Marcouiller Construction Services, LLC. We received payment #3 from the Township of Howell, for the 2010 Fire Taxes. The check, in the amount of \$350,000.00, was received and deposited on October 1, 2010. We received a service report from Continental Fire and Safety, Inc. for the service completed on our Air Compressor. This work was completed on September 30, 2010.

Legal

Joe read the resolution, dated July 5, 2010, which awarded a contract to Halecon, Inc. Joe also updated the Board on the Ramos vs. The Adelphia Fire Company. A ruling, which was made today, does not dismiss the case against The Adelphia Fire Company as of yet. Joe will keep us informed on what happens next.
